# CROSSING THE BORDER

One of Buffalo Niagara's greatest assets is its proximity to Canada. Travel between the U.S. and Canada is quick and convenient via the Peace Bridge, the Rainbow Bridge or Queenston-Lewiston Bridge. A nominal fee is charged per motorcoach. Both the U.S. and Canada have specific guidelines on the type and amount of goods that can be brought back into the country of origin.

The Western Hemisphere Travel Initiative, or WHTI, requires U.S. and Canadian travelers to present a passport or other document that denotes identity and citizenship when entering the U.S. For additional information, including document options and requirements for special audiences, please visit [GetYouHome.gov](http://GetYouHome.gov).

U.S. citizens returning home from Canada will be required to present one of the travel documents listed here:

- U.S. Passport
- U.S. Passport Card
- Enhanced Driver's License
- Trusted Traveler Program Cards such as NEXUS, SENTRI or FAST enrollment cards
- Special Audiences (Special documents for U.S. Lawful Permanent Residents, U.S. Military, Native Americans, and Boaters; birth certificates for children under the age of 16).

Canadian citizens entering the U.S. will be required to present one of the travel documents listed here:

- Canadian Passport
- Trusted Traveler Program Cards such as NEXUS or FAST/Express enrollment cards
- Enhanced Driver's License
- Special Audiences (Special documents for Native Americans and Boaters; birth certificates for children under the age of 16).

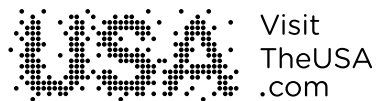

## SUGGESTIONS FOR CROSSING THE BORDER

- Have proof of citizenship readily available.
- Have birth certificates for each child on motorcoach.
- If traveling with children who are not a part of your family, have a note or proof that the child has permission to cross the border with you.
- Turn off radios and cellular phones when talking to border agents.
- Declare all fruits, vegetables, plants, plant products, animals, birds, eggs, meat, and meat products.
- Declare all items acquired for personal use.
- Resident aliens must carry residency cards at all times.
- Dogs and cats must be free of evidence of diseases communicable to humans. Dogs older than three months must have proof of a rabies vaccination.
- Don't fool around. Customs and Immigration agents on both sides of the border are law enforcement officials who take their duties very seriously.
- Be patient. Additional security has been instituted for safety on both sides of the border.

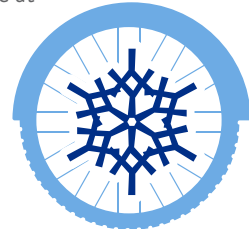


## **THE NEW HOCKEYTOWN**

# HOUSES OF WORSHIP TOUR

Western New York is rich in art, but not all of it is found in museums or galleries. For generations, believers and non-believers alike have been inspired by the art enshrined in Buffalo's houses of worship. Radiant stained-glass, paintings that have no equal, magnificent sculpture and

ornamentation, handmade bricks, terra cotta and tile work – and it's all there for you to enjoy. Four Buffalo churches invite you to be amazed by the faith of our immigrant ancestors and awestruck by the art they created.



CHUCK LACHIUSA

▶ On the National Register of Historic Places, **Blessed Trinity R. C. Church** is recognized as the purest replication of Lombard Romanesque architecture in the United States. The church's exterior features irregular "Harvard" brick walls laid using a medieval technique and terra-cotta ornamentation. The interior is noted for its extensive use of ceramics, including artisan floor tiles, pillars, altar baldachino and more than 2,000 decorative symbols.

▶ The **Buffalo Religious Art Center**, a unique example of adaptive reuse. A superb Romanesque Basilica Style church becomes a museum dedicated to the display of religious art.



CORPUS CHRISTI

▶ **Corpus Christi** is a landmark, Romanesque-styled church saved from closing in 2004 and currently undergoing a multi-million dollar historic restoration. The church is especially noted for its exquisite stained-glass windows and iconic mural above the church altar, considered to be one of the most significant examples of ecclesiastical artwork in the United States.

▶ **First Presbyterian Church** is the oldest faith community in Buffalo, established in 1812. The church's architecturally significant building on Symphony Circle features Tiffany-designed stained glass windows, two impressive pipe organs, and a 168-foot tall tower visible throughout the west side of the city.

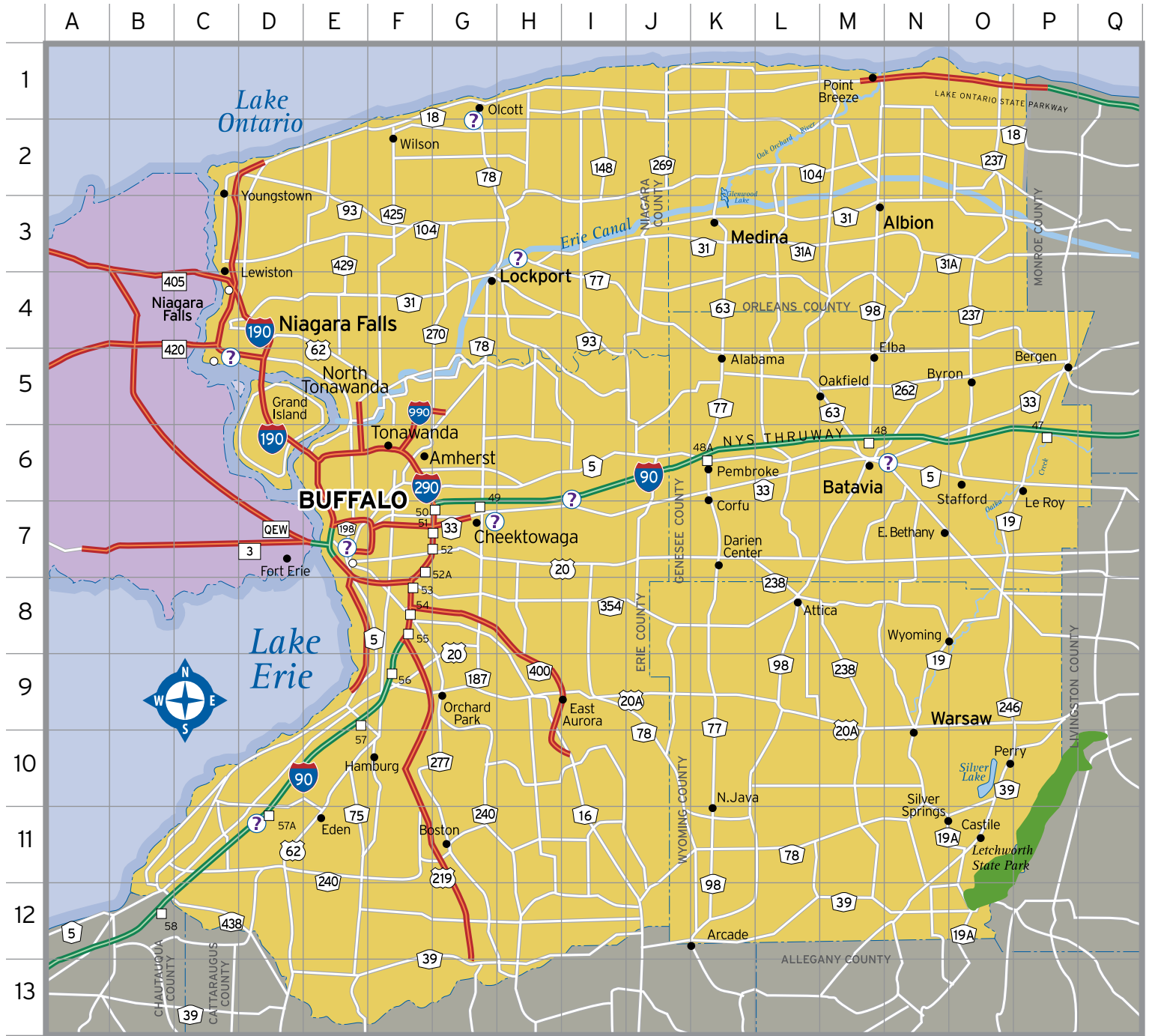

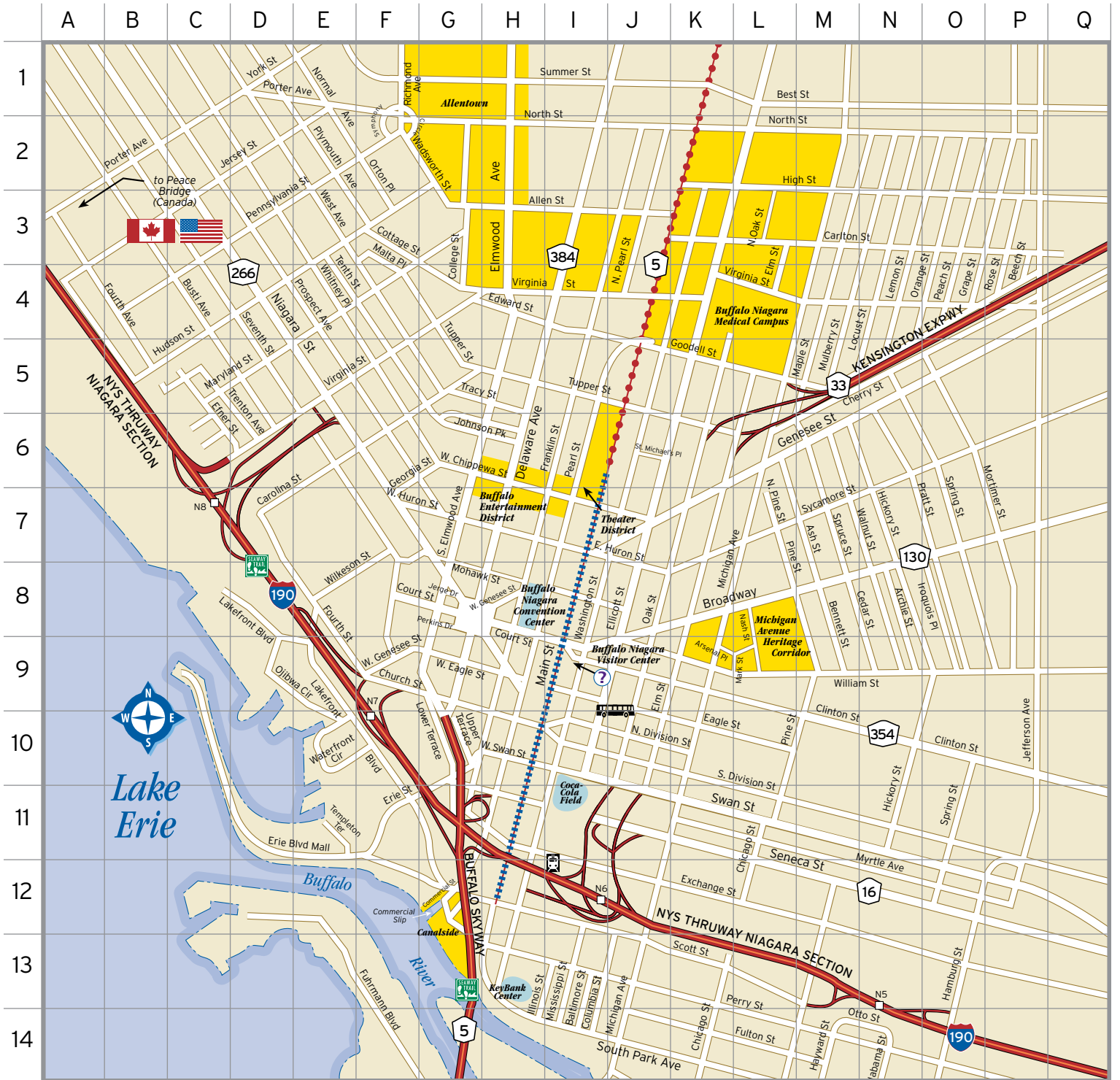
